DESCRIPTION

At the request of Professor Somchit Savathanaphaibul Director, Science Education Center, Srinakharinwirot University the Indiana University (IU), School of Education (SOE), Department of Curriculum and Instruction will continue to provide support and opportunities for three graduate students to visit, study, perform individual research and develop thesis proposals for their graduate degree programs.

While in residence the visiting scholars will participate with faculty in ongoing research efforts, become engaged with the IU faculty in revising and delivering instruction for our pre-service teachers, and observe and interact with local elementary, middle, and secondary school science teachers. The faculty of Science Education is interested in pursuing this project because it will give us the opportunity to renew the cooperation between Indiana University and Srinakharinwirot which was initiated over fifty years ago, facilitate the matriculation of Thai students to Indiana University, and create opportunities for us to extend our research to an international dimension.

PROVISIONS

Indiana University will continue to provide:

- Transportation for visiting scholars to and from Bloomington, Indiana and the Indianapolis International airport upon arrival and for departure
- Indiana University identification cards giving them status of Visiting Scholar
- Assistance in acquiring living accommodations.
- Assistance in purchasing or renting automobiles if needed.
- Orientation to Indiana University Campus, City of Bloomington and local shopping areas
- Full access to the Indiana University libraries, information resource centers and computer labs
- Free local telephone service from office space
- Health insurance for visiting scholars (\$250 deductible)
- Welcoming reception with IU Thai students, IU faculty, and project staff

Indiana University will not provide:

- Travel to and from point of origin (e.g. Thailand) and Indianapolis, Indiana.
- Living accommodations while at Indiana University. IU will assist in making arrangements for fully furnished apartments which will include provisions for cooking, cooking utensils, and linens, and TV. Utilities, if any, will be paid by visiting scholar
- Stipends for other living expenses such as entertainment, food, long distance telephone calls, clothing, gifts, other travel, local transportation, laundry, etc.
- Fee Remission, books and materials that visiting scholars may choose to purchase for professional/personal use.

Science Education Center Visiting Scholars will provide:

- Health and accident insurance for visiting scholars family members if they reside at Indiana University.
- Cost of all long distance telephone service.
- Cost of individual printing/duplication
- Cost of any and all conferences, seminars and training sessions the individuals may choose to attend

TERMS

The cost of this extension is computed at three (3) Visiting Scholars at \$36,093. The cost of additional visiting scholars is negotiable upon request. Payment is due upon commencement of extension date of the program (July 1, 2006). The term of this agreement is July 1, 2006 through June 30, 2007. A no-cost extension will be authorized to June 30, 2008. This Memorandum of Agreement is renewable for subsequent years upon mutual consent of both parties.

- Assistance in acquiring living accommodations in the IU Residential Housing complex. This complex is within walking distance to the SOE and most IU facilities.
- Assistance in purchasing or renting automobiles if needed.
- Orientation to Indiana University Campus, City of Bloomington and local shopping areas.
- Full access to the Indiana University Libraries, Information Resource Centers and Computer Labs
- Free local telephone service from office space.
- Health insurance for Visiting Scholars (\$250 Deductible)
- Welcoming reception with IU Thai students, IU faculty, and project staff.

IU/SRINAKHARINWIROT UNIVERSITY MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT

Indiana University will not provide:

- Travel to and from point of origin (e.g., Thailand) and Indianapolis, Indiana.
- Living accommodations while at Indiana University. IU will assist in making arrangements for fully furnished guest apartments which will include provisions for cooking, cooking utensils and linen service, TV, and all utilities. The apartments are two bedrooms and rent for \$1,100 per month.
- Stipends for other living expenses such as entertainment, food, long distance telephone calls, clothing, gifts, other travel, local transportation, laundry, etc.
- Fee Remission, books and materials that Visiting Scholars may choose to purchase for professional/personal use.

Science Education Center/or Visiting Scholars will provide:

- Health and accident insurance for Visiting Scholars family members if they reside at Indiana University
- Cost of all long distance telephone service.
- Cost of individual printing/duplication.
- Cost of any and all conferences, seminars and training sessions the individuals may choose to attend.

TERMS

This cost of this program is computed on a sliding scale for one (1) Visiting Scholar (\$32,751), two (2) Visiting Scholars (\$33,922), three (3) Visiting Scholars (\$35,093) and four (4) Visiting Scholars (\$36,263). The cost of additional Visiting Scholars is negotiable upon request. Payment is due upon commencement of the program. The Term of this agreement is July 1, 2005 through June 30, 2006. This Memorandum of Agreement is renewable for subsequent years upon mutual consent of both parties.
