Academic Cooperative Agreement between Srinakharinwirot University and National Taichung University of Education

National Taichung University of Education, Taichung. ROC. and Srinakharinwirot University. Bangkok. Kingdom of Thailand are interested in bringing a more global dimension to their curricula and research.

The agreement, therefore, is made as a gesture of goodwill between the two universities (or institutions) and mutual benefit through the cooperative effort in the following areas:

- 1. Exchange of students for joint degree, and non-degree curricula
- 2. Exchange of faculty members and staff
- 3. Exchange of academic materials and other information
- 4. Joint research activities and publications
- 5. Joint performance and exhibition activities
- 6. Participation in seminars/workshops and academic meetings
- 7. Participation in special short-term academic and cultural programs

This agreement shall be valid for **five years** from the date of signing. Revision or renewal of this cooperative link is subject to mutual consent of both parties.

It is expected that this agreement will lead to other more specific collaborative agreements between the two institutions. Details of the implementation of any particular activities resulting from this agreement shall be negotiated between the two universities as such specific cases arise.

Either party may terminate the agreement by written notification signed by the appropriate official of the party initiating the notice. Such notification must be received by the other party at least six months prior to the effective date of termination.

This agreement serves as the intention of both parties to work together to promote academic and educational linkage. It does not have any legal binding on the part of the universities involved.
