ACADEMIC COOPERATIVE AGREEMENT
BETWEEN
MINISTRY OF TOURISM OF
THE ROYAL GOVERNMENT OF CAMBODIA
AND
SRINAKHARINWIROT UNIVERSITY , THAILAND

The Ministry of Tourism and Srinakharinwirot University are interested in bringing a more global dimension to their curriculum and research through faculty exchange with institutions in various countries as well as in strengthening the Khmer - Thai studies programs. Therefore, this agreement is entered for mutual benefit of both institutions.

The agreement is made as a good gesture of goodwill between the two institutions in the following areas of a cooperative effort, commencing with the 1995 academic years, subject to mutual consent and the availability of sufficient funding:

- 1) Staff development in Eco-Tourism through offering of scholarships and/or training at Srinakharinwirot University
- 2) Khmer-Thai Eco-Tourism studies through research projects with Srinakharinwirot University Institute of Asia Pacific Studies
- 3) Eco-Tourism textbook program (in Khmer) supervised jointly by Khmer - Thai committee


Responsibility of co-ordination of this agreement will rest with the Vice President of International Relations Office at Srinakharinwirot University and the Ministry of Tourism.

Details of the implementation of any particular exchange resulting from this agreement shall be negotiated between the two institutions as such specific cases arise.

This agreement is subject to revision, renewal by mutual consent.

Either party may terminate the agreement by written notification signed by the appropriate official of the party initiating the notice. Such notification must be received by the other party at least six months prior to the effective date of termination.
