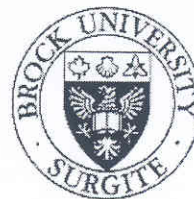


Agreement of Academic
Cooperation
between
**Srinakharinwirot
University**
and
Brock University



Brock University, St. Catharines, Ontario, Canada and Srinakharinwirot University, Bangkok, Thailand are interested in bringing a more global dimension to their curricula and research, particularly in the fields of Biological Sciences, Cultural Studies, Ecology, Environment and Language Instruction.

The agreement, therefore, is made as a gesture of goodwill between the two universities and mutual benefit through the cooperative effort in the following areas:

1. Development of joint degree and non-degree curricula
2. Exchange of faculty members
3. Exchange of academic materials and other information
4. Joint research activities
5. Participation in seminars/workshops and academic meetings
6. Special short-term academic programs
7. Staff development
8. Student exchange for research and study

This agreement shall be valid for **5 years** from the date of signing. Revision or renewal of this cooperative link is subject to mutual consent of both parties.

It is expected that this agreement will lead to other more specific collaborative agreements between the two institutions. Details of the implementation of any particular activities resulting from this agreement shall be negotiated between the two universities as such specific cases arise.

Either party may terminate the agreement by written notification signed by the appropriate official of the party initiating the notice. Such notification must be received by the other party at least six months prior to the effective date of termination.

This agreement serves as the intention of both parties to work together to promote academic and educational linkage. It does not have any legal binding on the part of the universities involved.
