



Agreement of Academic Cooperation between The School of Travel Industry Management University of Hawaii at Manoa and

Srinakharinwirot University



The School of Travel Industry Management, the University of Hawaii at Manoa, the United States of America and Srinakharinwirot University, Thailand agree to cooperate in regard to international programs based on the principle of reciprocity. By the establishment of such exchanges, the instructional and research activities at both universities will be enhanced and mutual understanding between scholars and students will be increased.

This agreement, therefore, is made as a gesture of goodwill between the School of Travel Industry Management, the University of Hawaii at Manoa and the Faculty of Social Science, Srinakharinwirot University as mutually beneficial through cooperative efforts in the following areas:

- 1. Development of joint degree and non-degree curricula
- 2. Exchange of faculty members and scholars
- 3. Exchange of students
- 4. Exchange of research and development of collaborative projects
- 5. Participation in seminars/workshops and academic meetings
- 6. Development of staff and faculty members

This agreement shall be valid for **5 years**. Revision or renewal of this cooperative link is subject to the mutual consent of both parties. Either party may terminate the agreement by written notification signed by the appropriate official of the party initiating the notice, although such action will only be taken after mutual consultation in order to avoid any possible inconvenience to all parties.

Details of the implementation of any particular activities resulting from this agreement shall be negotiated between the two universities as such specific cases arise. This agreement serves as the intention of both parties to work together to promote academic and educational linkage. It does not have any legal binding on part of the universities involved.
