MEMORANDUM FOR INTERNATIONAL COOPERATION AND INTERCHANGE IN ACADEMIC ACTIVITIES

between

SRINAKHARINWIROT UNIVERSITY, THAILAND

and

THE UNIVERSITY OF QUEENSLAND, AUSTRALIA

In order to strengthen cooperation and interchange in teaching and research between the two universities, both sides express their intention to establish affiliations in accordance with the following principles.

- It is the intention of the undersigned that there should be mutual exchange of academic materials, including such items as scientific publications, curricula information, and pertinent research reports.
- 2. It is the hope of the undersigned that each university will nominate students to be associated with the other university for study and research. The respective universities will carry the responsibility for the nomination of their own students while the acceptance will be wholly within the province of the host university. Financial responsibility for each student should be carried by the university that sends the student. This is not intended to preclude the possibility that a student may apply for and be awarded a scholarship or similar grant for which he or she may be eligible.
- 3. It is further intended that, subject to the host university's agreement in each case, there should be visits of academic staff from each institution who will engage in research and advanced study and may give seminars. Such staff will undertake research free of research charge. Their travelling expenses (both international and inland) will be borne by the sending university. Each side will provide visiting scholars from the other with facilities for work. The host university will assist the visiting scholar in matters of health, language, and local custom that may arise in the course of the visit.
- 4. Each university may invite academic staff from the other to visit in order to give lectures. In such a case their travelling (both international and inland), as well as research expenses during their stay will be borne by the host university.
- 5. It is intended that where possible, each university will invite scholars from the other solely to participate in conferences, workshops and academic discussions and will include scholars visiting the university for longer periods in such conferences, workshops, and academic discussions. All expenses are to be paid by the participants but the host university may offer, but is in no way committed, to meet all or a portion of the costs.
- 6. Each side will give prior notification to the other side of the names of the staff members of the two universities who will participate in delegations and attend academic conferences in the other country so as to maximise opportunity to discuss matters of mutual exchange and cooperation.

The above mentioned terms are to be carried out beginning in the academic year of 1984. A working plan is to be made by both universities once a year either jointly or through an exchange of the draft working plan made by either side. The plan is to be carried out pending approval by both universities.
